# Village of Sunbury 1816–2016

The name “Sunbury” was established in Delaware County, Ohio well before William and Lawrence Myers platted the town on Nov. 9, 1816. Eight years earlier, county commissioners formed Sunbury township, which took in the balance of the county not previously laid out. In 1816, the Village of Sunbury was laid out in Berkshire Township by Pennsylvania brothers William and Lawrence Myers.

**Myers Inn**

One of the oldest structure in Sunbury is the Myers Inn. Enclosed in this structure is the first one room house of Lawrence Myers which may date to 1816 and the two story stage coach inn built by Lawrence Myers in 1820. Both frame structures were enclosed into this large building by Jeduthan Skeels in the 1870's.
